# Thursday, Day 1: Welcome to the Southwest!


When you arrive in Santa Fe, Soltesz Fine Art Tours and Gallery MAR will be there to welcome you.

# Saturday, Day 3: A Day of Delights - Art, Food, and Wine

Today we dive into the Santa Fe gallery scene. With its diverse collection of over 50 galleries peppering this one street, Canyon Road is an art mecca for any art lover. We begin the day with a gallery tour lead by Melissa Soltesz. Melissa will lead us through a selection of galleries and share artist highlights at each stop.

- Private art tour through some of Santa Fe's top galleries. Get insight into style, medium, technique, and pricing of artwork. This will be an informative and fun way to begin our adventure into the gallery scene, led by an expert tour guide.
- Canyon Road has a lot to explore and we want you to have time to see all that you want to see. After the tour we will have a quick lunch so you can continue exploring. After lunch you can venture out on your own or choose to continue wandering with your guides.
- Tonight we have a lovely private dinner and wine pairing in the Library Room at the Inn at the Anasazi. We'll enjoy culinary delights paired with exquisite wine selections. Over dinner we'll unwind and share our favorite finds of the day, in the company of Gallery MAR artists.

#### Sunday, Day 4: Santa Fe through the Eyes of Georgia O'Keeffe

When you think of art in Santa Fe, Georgia O'Keeffe is typically the first artist that comes to mind. O'Keeffe spent decades of her life in Santa Fe and her work was continually inspired by the Southwest landscape. This morning we will have a private tour of the Georgia O'Keeffe museum with the museum's curator. Following the tour we will venture out into the landscape for a hike and discover firsthand what inspired O'Keeffe's work.

- Private curator-led tour of the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum and be one of the first groups to experience the latest exhibition at the museum.
- Following our tour we will stretch our legs and head to the hills for a moderate hike through the red rock landscape. Make sure you have your camera handy!
